We would like to thank you for giving us the opportunity to assist you in developing superior driving skills. It is our goal to provide each student with the necessary information and skills to become Low Risk Drivers. Driving practice is a crucial key to skill development. Therefore, we highly encourage family participation. Your parents/guardians, and Superior Driving School are a winning combination in your Superior Skill Development.

Course Requirement: State regulations require each student to meet certain objectives and reach certain skill levels before a Certificate of Completion can be issued. To ensure successful completion of the program, we will make every effort to assist student having difficulty. Parents/guardians, and students will be informed if student is not meeting performance standards.

Performance Standards for program completion and issuance of Certificate:

- Attend all scheduled classroom sessions or make-up classes. There is a \$20.00 fee for a missed class (with-out-approval).
- A minimum of 80% on all test. Make-up tests are available. Private tutoring is available for \$70.00 per hour.
- Qualify on all Behind-the-Wheel instructions. Extra drives are \$70.00 per 1 hour session.

School Policies:

1. No smoking in classrooms or vehicles at anytime.
2. Zero Tolerance for any forms of harassment or disruptive behavior, bullying, mobbing, profanity, or vandalism. After two (2) warning, this will result in course Expulsion, without refund.
3. State regulations requires that each student must have a valid learners permit or license before starting the Behind-the-Wheel instructions of the program. The permit or license must be shown to the driver before each driving lesson.
4. All Behind-the-Wheel drives are scheduled by the student and agreed upon by the student and instructor. A 24 hour cancellation of drives is required. A \$40.00 No Show fee will be charged if we are not Notified. Students will also be charged a \$40.00 fee if they do not have their permit or license at the time of their drive.
5. Traffic Safety Education Certificate will be issued within 3 business days after course completion. A fee of \$30.00 will be charged for a Certificate Replacement.
6. A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for any Returned Checks.

Refund Policy: Students are eligible to receive a partial refund within the first week of class only. A \$70.00 Administrative fee will be charged. No refunds after the first 3 classes.
